

8. Name, mailing address, physical address, and telephone number of EACH OCCUPANT of any of the land where the dirt work will be done:

9. Sign and attach a plan and drawing of the proposed action, showing each of the items listed below. The information and drawings required by this section need not be to scale or prepared by a surveyor or engineer, unless the City Floodplain Administrator determines, in his sole discretion, that such requirements are necessary in order to make the information adequately reliable, considering the items listed below.

- a. Overall layout of the subject tract and neighboring tracts;
- b. Elevations and contours of the subject tract;
- c. All slopes, drainage features, and drainage structures, such as ditches, swales, waterways, ponds, holes, mounds, ridges, berms, and dams;
- d. All pavement, structures, and water runoff from pavement and structures;
- e. The paths of water upon, to, from, within, and across the property;
- f. Flood zones and floodways as determined by the applicable FEMA maps, the Base Flood Elevation (BFE), and the flood zone;
- g. Any proposed drainage improvements including any detention areas and depths with preliminary calculations;
- h. Any proposed easements which shall include all drainage and maintenance easements;
- i. The drainage facilities and features on adjoining and nearby property that affect the entry of water onto the property or that affect the receipt or direction of runoff onto such other property from the property in question;
- j. The effect of the proposed work or structure upon the drainage the subject property and of neighboring and nearby property; and
- k. Any other information requested by the City Floodplain Administrator concerning the drainage impact of the proposed project.

A nonrefundable application fee for a Dirt Work permit shall be paid to the City at the time the permit application is filed, unless the Dirt Work is part of the work under a valid building permit. The amount of the fee shall be as follows:

Dirt Work Permit Fee	Cubic Yards of Dirt to be Moved Pursuant to the Permit
Dirt Work Permit Not Required.....	Less than 70
\$40.00	at least 70 and under 140
\$60.00.....	at least 140 and under 280
\$60.00 ; plus \$1.50 for each 14 cubic yards or fraction thereof in excess of 280 cubic yards.....	280 and above
